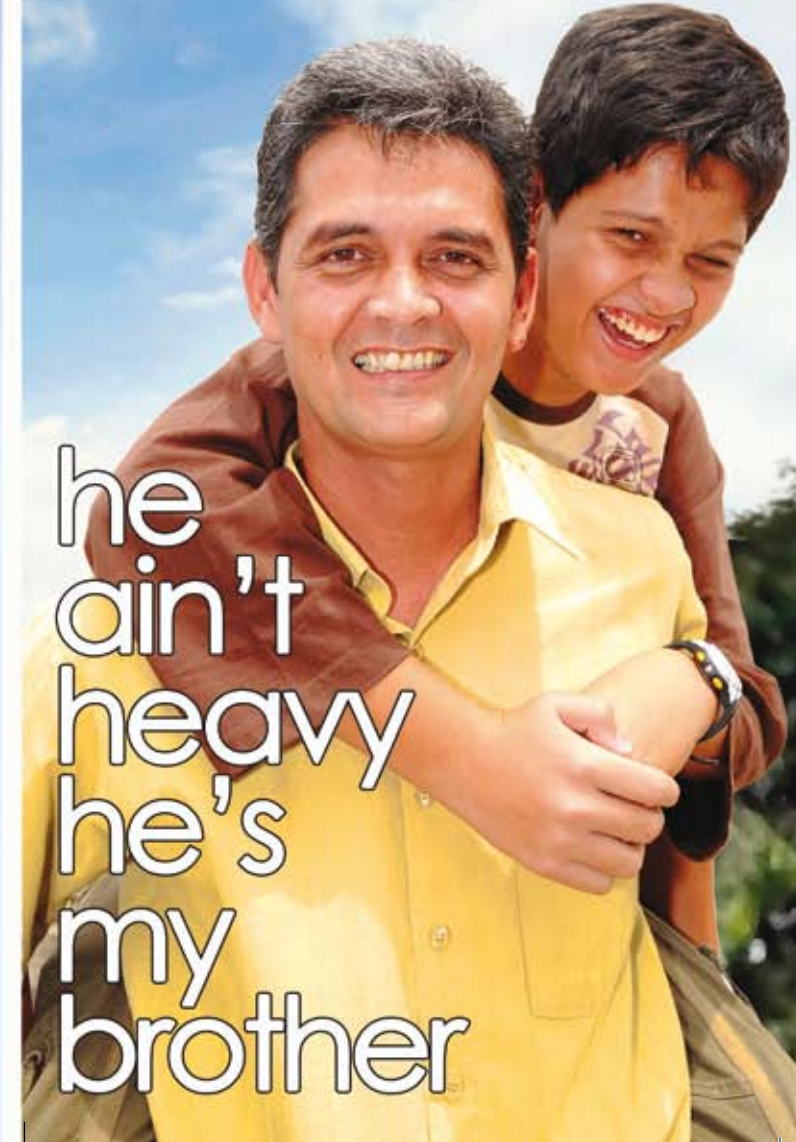

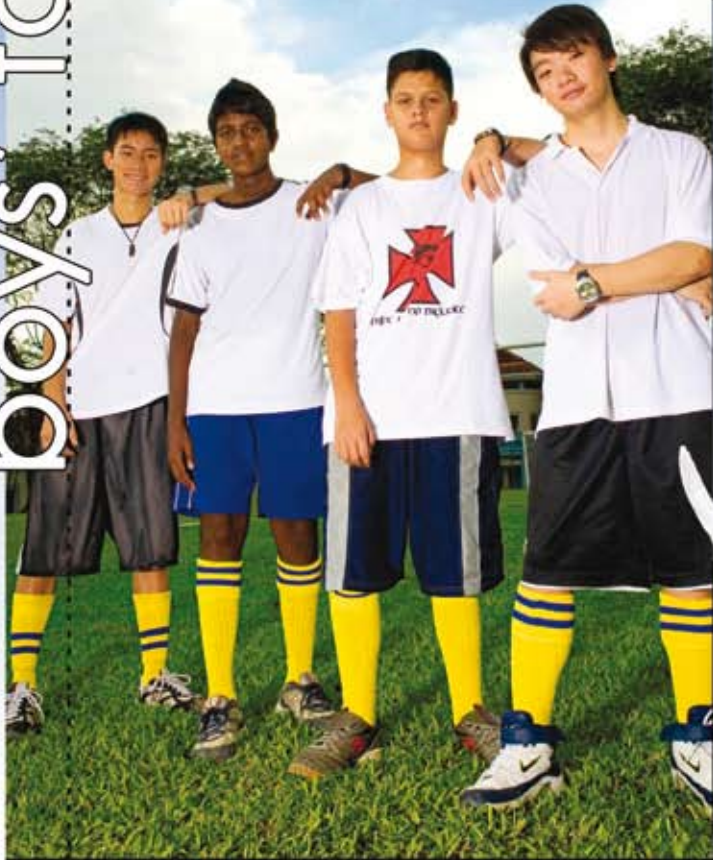

## our community

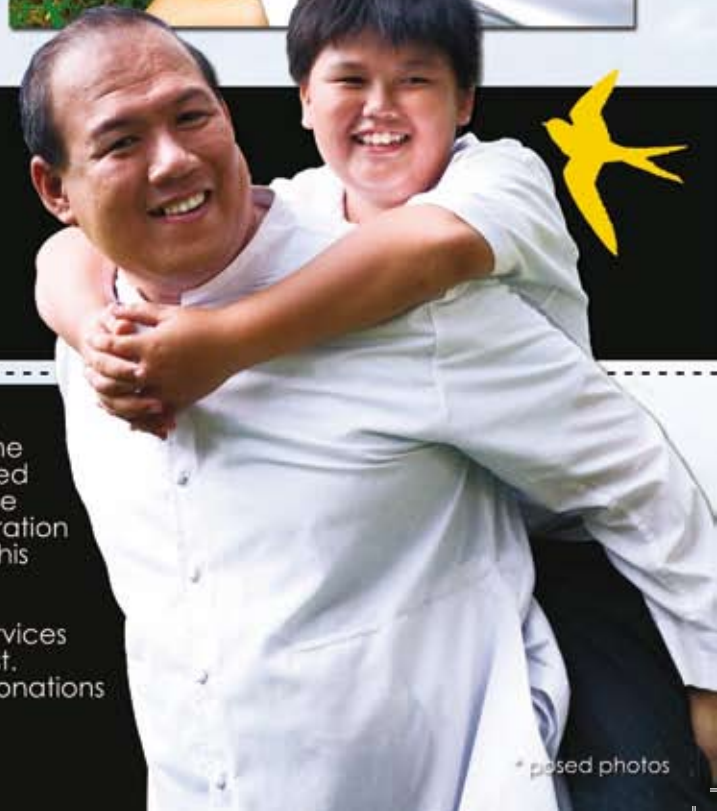
Aside from our Boys' Town residential programme, our campus also consists of **Assumption English School**, which is a co-ed secondary school; **Assumption Vocational Institute**, which provides vocational training; and **Boys' Town Alumni**, which completes our Boys' Town community.

## who we are

Boys' Town was established in 1948 as a charitable institution dedicated to providing youths between the ages of 11 and 18 with guidance, shelter, education, vocational training and practical living skills. The boys under our care come primarily from troubled, single parent and/or financially needy families as well as those who find themselves in various states of difficulties. Boys' Town strives to build a nurturing and loving environment for our boys. Our work ethos is reflected in our motto "**He ain't heavy, he's my brother.**"

**Bro. Vincent from the Brothers of St. Gabriel and Mr. W.T. McDermott**, an Australian philanthropist, first came up with the idea of setting up a Boys' Town similar to the one in the United States. They met at Changi Prison Camp during the Japanese Occupation and Mr. McDermott expressed his greatest aspiration to establish a Boys' Town for Singapore. They embarked on this project after their release from Changi Prison.

Boys' Town is a member of the National Council of Social Services but does not receive any funding from the Community Chest. As we are an Institute of Public Character (IPC) charity, all donations are eligible for tax exemption.
