- In what ways do I contribute to the welfare or harmony of others, including my family, community, friends and even to my enemies?
- When I contribute to the welfare & harmony of others, what do I experience?
- Read the newspaper clipping about the ‘Difference’ that youths are making in Singapore. What do you think about it?
- Are they any different from you and me?
- Read Luke 10 : 29-37 (Parable of the Good Samaritan)
- Read James 1 : 19-27 (True Religion – Listening & Action)
